Planting & Care

Grow firecracker flower in a pot filled with moist potting soil that s rich in organic matter and holds moisture well. Use a pot with bottom drainage holes so excess moisture doesn t collect in the bottom of the pot and cause root rot.

**Sunlight:** Full Sun

**Soil:** well-drained soil

**Water:** medium

**Temperature:** 70-75°F/ 21-24°C.

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer

**Care:**

- Set the plant in an indoor area that receives direct sunlight for at least six hours daily.
- Place outdoor plants in a location with bright morning sun and light afternoon shade.

**Special Feature:**

Container plant. Houseplant.
