Noni is a small evergreen shrub or tree, usually less than 10 feet high, occasionally rising to 20 feet.

Planting and care

Select a site in full or partial sun with well drained, well aerated soil. Avoid heavy soils, compacted areas, and flood-prone sites.

Caring for Cheese Fruit

- The right growing conditions will help nurture a noni shrub, and will also help prevent most serious insect pests and diseases. Full sun is best, but a noni will also tolerate light shade. Deep shade decreases flowering and fruiting and may shorten the lifespan of the shrub.

Typical uses of Cheese Fruit

Special features: In ancient times, Noni was a valuable dye plant.

Culinary use: Fruits are edible

Medicinal use: It is a medicinal plant.
