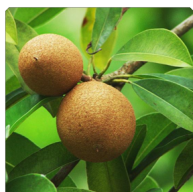

Description Manilkara zapota, commonly known as the sapodilla is a long-lived, evergreen tree native to It is called ciku (pronounced chiku) in standard Malay and sawo nilo in Kelantanese Malay. In Chinese, the name is mistakenly translated by many

Common name: Sapodilla plum

Color: dark-brown

Bloom time: monsoon.

Height: 9 and 15 m (30 and 49 ft)

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Despite its temperature tolerance, if you want to grow a sapodilla tree in a less than semi-tropical area, it would be prudent to either grow it in a greenhouse or as a container plant that can be moved to a protected area in case of inclement weather.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: medium

Temperature: 26-28 F. (-2 to -3 C.

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Sapodilla can grow to more than 30 m (98 ft) tall with an average trunk diameter of 1.
- 5 m (4.
- 9 ft).
- The average height of cultivated specimens, however, is usually between 9 and 15 m (30 and 49 ft) with a trunk diameter not exceeding

50 cm (20 in).

- [5] It is wind-resistant and the bark is rich in a white, gummy latex called chicle.
- The ornamental leaves are medium green and glossy.
- They are alternate, elliptic to ovate, 7–15 cm long, with an entire margin.
