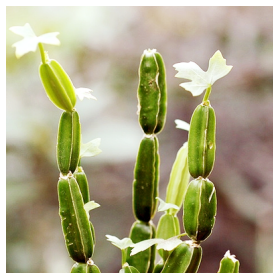

- Maintain moderate soil moisture and fertilize lightly.
- plant will die with the first frost.
