Planting and care

Growing plants can be inexpensive, particularly when growing them from seed. Seeds of plants flowers should usually be sown directly into the sunny flower bed, as developing roots do not like to be disturbed

Caring for Crassula Hobbit

- Deadhead to prolong flowering.

- Maintain moderate soil moisture and fertilize lightly.
- plant will die with the first frost.

Typical uses of Crassula Hobbit

Special features: The Campfire crassula is a branching succulent with fleshy propeller-like leaves that mature from bright lime green to bright red. Leaves turn bright red if not over-watered and the plant receives direct sun for most of the day, during drought or in cold temperatures.

Ornamental use: The plant is used for ornamental purpose
