Description Cubeb, or tailed pepper is a plant in genus Piper, cultivated for its fruit and essential oil. It is mostly grown in Java and Sumatra, hence sometimes called Java pepper. The fruits are gathered before they are ripe, and carefully dried

Common name: Piper cubeba

Color: dark gray to black.

Bloom time: rarely and only for a short time.

Height: 18 – 20 feet

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Most outdoor varieties can endure temperatures as low as 50°F (10°C) without any problem. That being said, fifty degrees is still not an ideal temperature because it tends to slow down tissue growth and photosynthesis later in the day

Sunlight: Full Sun

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: medium

Temperature: 70 and 75°F (21-23°C)

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- These outdoor plants can also benefit from a polyethylene plastic covering that keeps things nice and toasty while also protecting the garden from the elements.
