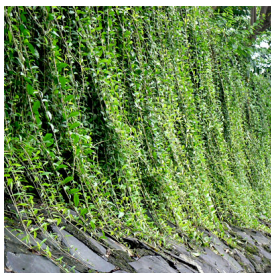


Curtain creeper, Vernonia creeper, Parda bel - Plant

Description for Curtain creeper, Vernonia creeper, Parda bel

Climbers are great for screening unsightly areas of the garden, brightening up bare walls and adding height to your borders.

Climbers are a versatile group of plants - use climbing plants to cover fences, walls, trellis, arches or obelisks! You can also train certain shrubs as "wall shrubs"™ for the same effect.

Planting and care

The plant may need supplemental water during extended periods of drought but can tolerate short periods of dryness.

The vine is remarkably versatile and vigorous.

It can stand alone with little external influence but will grow thicker and more lush with annual fertilizer and shearing.

Occasional pruning is a part of Virginia creeper maintenance.

When left to its own devices the vine can grow 10 to 30 feet long. Annual trimming will help keep it to a size that is manageable.

Caring for Curtain creeper

- Virginia creeper is a carefree plant. It is a deciduous perennial vine with a woody stem.
- The plant will bloom in June to July with green inconspicuous flowers.
- They turn into round ball-like fruits, which persist on the vine and add interest
- can cut these off if you have children, as they are highly toxic.
- Birds will enjoy them if you leave them on the vine.
- Watch for leafhoppers, scale and Japanese beetles. Treat with the appropriate insecticide to quell these types of invaders.
