Description Cypripedium parviflorum, commonly known as yellow lady s slipper, moccasin flower, or hairy yellow ladyslipper is a lady s slipper orchid found in North America.

Common name: slipper orchid

Color: Creamy yellow with purplish brown sepals

Bloom time: April to June

Height: 1.50 to 2.50 feet

Difficulty level: :easy to grow

Planting & Care

Best grown in rich, well-drained soils in part shade. Likes moist boggy areas. Prefers part shade with 1-2 hours of morning or evening sun in cool summer climates with moderately cold winters. Best performance occurs in USDA Zones 3-7 (Zone 8 if plants are given additional shade)

Sunlight: :Full Sun

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: medium

Temperature: 70 and 78°F (21-26°C).

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- The Lady Slipper's need for shade translates into placement by an east or west window that's covered with a sheer or venetian blinds.
- The Lady Slipper plant can even thrive in an interior setting like a coffee table or interior kitchen counter.

Special Feature:

Moist woodland areas. This rare plant will be very difficult to obtain in commerce.

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose.

No serious insect or disease problems.
