Description for Daffodil Tahiti (Yellow, Orange)

Daffodil is spring blooming perennial plants of the Amaryllidaceae family. The plants are scapose, having a single central leafless hollow flower stem. Several green or blue-green, narrow, strap-shaped leaves arise from the bulb. The plant stem usually bears a solitary flower, but occasionally a cluster of flowers (umbel). Flowers may be single or double, grow singly on a stem or with multiple flowers per stem, and height varies from 6 to 20 inches. This trumpet shape contains the stamens and is the most conspicuous feature of the flower.

Common name(s): Daffodil, Daffadowndilly, Narcissus, Jonquil

Flower colours: Yellow, Orange color

Bloom time: Spring

Max reachahle height: Up to 18 inches

Difficulty to grow:: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Sowing season of Daffodil bulb in the rainy, autumn, and early winter season. Before sowing, you can keep the bulb in the refrigerator in a ventilated mesh bag for 2 to 3 weeks. The highest chilling temperature is around 4 C. Dig a hole about three times as deep as the height of the

bulb. Set the bulb in the hole, pointy end up, then cover with soil and press firmly. Space bulbs 4 to 6 inches apart. Water thoroughly after planting.

Use the potting mix for bulb plantation as
Garden soil + Compost + Perlite + Sand (2:2:1:1)
Soil + Cocopeat + vermicompost (2:1:2)

Sunlight: Full sun to partial shade

Soil: Sandy loam soil

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 20 to 30 degrees C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

Caring for Daffodil Tahiti

- At the time of chilling, fruits do not keep near the bulbs.
- Water a plant when the soil feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering for the winter & rainy season.
- Try to water the plants in the morning around 8-10am.
- You should remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and throw in the garbage collector.
- You should fertilize a plant mostly in the spring season, flower bud stage.
- Mulch the potting mix with organic material.

Typical uses of Daffodil Tahiti

Special features: Attractive flowers

Ornamental use: Daffodils bring cheer to the spring garden with abundant flowers.
