Description The Thanksgiving cactus is also commonly called the holiday or crab cactus. It grows best in light shade. Full sunlight is beneficial in midwinter, but bright sun during the summer months can make plants look pale and yellow.

Common name: Schlumbergera truncata

Color: Red, purple, pink, white

Bloom time: Seasonal bloomer

Height: 0.75 to 1.00 feet

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Keep them potbound in sandy soil. Water only when the soil is completely dry.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Dry to medium

Temperature: 65–75°F

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Provide some humidity to the environment.
- Don't worry if some of the buds drop off - it's natural for the plant to lose a few.

Special Feature:

In its native area, Schlumbergera truncata is grown outdoors as an epiphyte or in rock gardens. In cooler climates, this plant can be grown in baskets or pots for brightly-lit window sills. It is sold primarily around the holiday season as a gift or decorative item.

Use

Ornamental use:

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose

Note:

This cactus commonly drops unopened flower buds, which may be induced by an excessive number of buds or a sudden change in temperature, light or other environmental factors, such as drying out of the growing medium.
