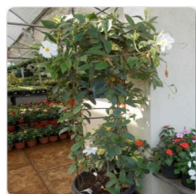

## Description for Decorative Items

The Thanksgiving cactus is also commonly called the holiday or crab cactus. It grows best in light shade. Full sunlight is beneficial in midwinter, but bright sun during the summer months can make plants look pale and yellow.

## Planting and care

Keep them potbound in sandy soil. Water only when the soil is completely dry.

Sunlight	Soil	Water	Temperature	Fertilizer
Full Sun to Partial Shade	Well-drained soil	Dry to medium	65 to 75 degrees C	Apply any organic fertilizer

## Caring for Decorative Items

Provide some humidity to the environment. Don't worry if some of the buds drop off - it's natural for the plant to lose a few.

## Typical uses of Decorative Items

**Special features:** In its native area, *Schlumbergera truncata* is grown outdoors as an epiphyte or in rock gardens. In cooler climates, this plant can be grown in baskets or pots for brightly-lit window sills. It is sold primarily around the holiday season as a gift or decorative item.

**Ornamental use:** The plant is used for ornamental purpose
