The hardy Ice Plants are native to dry areas in South Africa but are amazingly hardy in North America, provided they are grown in very well-drained soil. This species forms a spreading carpet of succulent evergreen leaves, bearing starry yellow flowers for months on end.

Common name: Gold Nugget

Color: Yellow

Bloom time: Late Spring to Early Fall.

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Growing plants can be inexpensive, particularly when growing them from seed. Seeds of plants flowers should usually be sown directly into the sunny flower bed, as developing roots do not like to be disturbed.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: about +20°C [68°F].

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Deadhead to prolong flowering.
- Maintain moderate soil moisture and fertilize lightly.
- Zinnias will die with the first frost.

Special Feature:

This very cold hardy ice plant is a small growing variety with large, shiny yellow flowers on top of bright green succulent foliage. ... In bloom, Delosperma congestum is irresistible; the large, shiny yellow flowers sit right on top of the succulent foliage and have a distinct white Use
