### Description for Dracaena Mahatma, Cordyline Terminalis Mahatma

Cordyline fruticosa typically grows as a short tree or shrub his is a long-lived broadleaf evergreen that features thin lance-shaped leaves that emerge pinkish red, but mature to deep green. Scented, white to pale lavender flowers appear in panicles. Houseplants rarely flower and fruit, however. As the plant ages, it loses its lower leaves.

### Planting and care

The best way to grow dracaenas is to buy a small one from us and plant it in a simple pot. After that, the necessary care is very simple. Plants that are dark green usually require less light than those that have any kind of colour in their leaves. The less light a plant has, the slower it grows. The slower it grows the less water and fertilizer it needs.

## Caring for Dracaena Mahatma

- Grows best in a well-drained, peaty potting mixture.
- Plants need bright indirect light but tolerate light shade. Avoid direct sun.
- Needs consistently moist soils from spring to fall.
