## Description for Euphorbia tithymaloides, Pedilanthus (Variegated)

**Plant height:** 5 - 9 inches

**Plant spread:** 4 - 6 inches

Euphorbia tithymaloides is a popular, erect, perennial, succulent; grow up to 8 feet tall. The leaf is oval, slightly glossy, variegated, medium green and white edged. They flank the zigzag stems to resemble a crooked backbone with ribs.

**Common name(s):** Variegated Devils Backbone, Japanese Poinsettia, Slipper Spurge, Redbird Cactus

**Flower colours:** Red

**Bloom time:** Rarely flowers indoors

**Max reachable height:** Up to 6 feet

**Difficulty to grow:** Easy to grow

## Planting and care

Re-pot when the plant performs clump and goes beyond the pot size. It should be done before or after the rainy season and in the spring season.

Re-pot with the following proportions: 3 parts of potting soil, 1 part of grit (pumice), 1 part of the horticultural-grade sand, 1/2 part of the compost etc.

**Sunlight:** Full Sun to Partial Shade

**Soil:** Well-drained soil

**Water:** Medium

**Temperature:** 60 degrees C

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer.

### Caring for Euphorbia tithymaloides

- Keep in a bright sunny location.
- Try not to water the leaves, give water to soil only.
- Avoid overwatering as the roots may get rot.
- Water the plant in a morning, between 8 to 10 am.
- Avoid keeping in suffocated areas or in a dark room.
- While re-potting or propagating try not to disturb the roots.
- Required care in the winter season. If growing in a pot, then kept in indoors and growing in outside do mulching.

### Typical uses of Euphorbia tithymaloides

**Special features:** Small succulent subshrub for sunny indoor areas. Zigzag stems exude a poisonous milky sap when cut.

**Ornamental use:** The plant is used for ornamental purpose.
