Description Euphrasia is a genus of about 450 species of herbaceous flowering plants in the family Orobanchaceae, with a cosmopolitan distribution. They are semi-parasitic on grasses and other plants

Common name: Euphrasia tatarica,

Color: white or purplish

Bloom time: July and September

Height: 4-8 inches (10-20 cm)

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Sow seeds in autumn to allow 90 days of chilling. Eyebright requires a period of chilling to break dormancy and trigger germination in spring. Alternatively, provide 90 days of artificial chilling by placing seeds in a moist growing medium in the refrigerator. Moisten several cups of commercial seed-starting mix, place in a plastic storage bag,

Sunlight: Full Sun

Soil: well-drained soi

Water: medium

Temprature: 35 ° C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Choose a grassy site that receives full sun.
- Eyebright grows naturally in sunny grasslands and meadows and draws nutrients from the roots of nearby plants.
- .
- The grass, however, should not be too thick and vigorous.

Special Feature:

basic organic compounds, and a plant based volatile oil unique to the eyebright.

Use

Medicinal use:

- mouth to treat swollen (inflamed) nasal passages, allergies, hay fever

Ornamental use:

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose
