Description Fennel is a flowering plant species in the carrot family. It is a hardy, perennial herb with yellow flowers and feathery leaves.

Planting & Care

The dark, fine-textured foliage of this short-lived perennial herb combined with its height (up to 6 feet tall) make it a great background for borders or herb gardens. It attracts beneficial insects and feeds the caterpillars that morph into swallowtail butterflies.

Sunlight: Full sun

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 250°C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Highly aromatic and slightly odd plant that is a poor companion for everything.
- It can grow close to dill, however, they tend to cross pollinate.
- On the other hand, fennel attracts a variety of beneficial insects into the garden.
- Aphids dislike fennel so they are repelled by it.
- Fennel is also a flea repellent.

Special Feature:

Borders, vegetable gardens, herb gardens, cottage gardens or meadows. Good plant for a butterfly garden.
