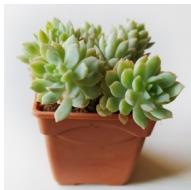
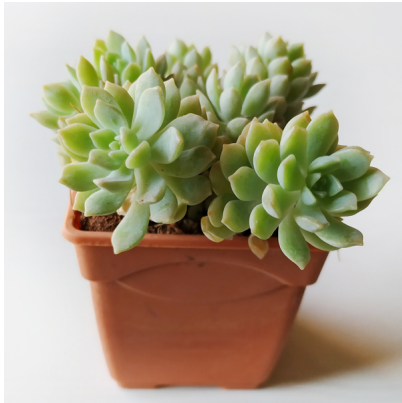


## Golden Sedum, Sedum adolphii Lime Gold - Succulent Plant

## Description for Golden Sedum, Sedum adolphii Lime Gold

**Plant height:** 2 - 5 inches

**Plant spread:** 3 - 5 inches

It is tender succulent plant upto a height of 8 inches. The leaves are lime green with red-orange flushed tips as they mature. They are more golden in the sun. It blooms in spring with small, star-shaped, yellow-white flower heads produced at the tips.

**Common name(s):** Golden sedum

**Flower colours:** white-yellow

**Bloom time:** Spring

**Max reachable height:** 8 inches

## Planting and care

**Sunlight:** Full sun to partial shade.

**Soil:** Well drained soil.

**Water:** Moderately

**Temperature:** 20-26 degrees C

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer in spring.

## Caring for Golden Sedum

- Once established, sedum plants require little care. Check your plants regularly to make sure they are not too dry and water when needed.
- After flowering, cut back the plants to maintain their shape or contain them in one area.
- Remember to divide your plants in the spring or fall to control their spread.
