Description Baby s Breath are a tender and delicate annual flower. Growing Baby s Breath is very easy, and they are quick to bloom. A popular flower to accent bouquets, corsages and flower vases, Baby s Breath is a popular flower in the home garden too.

Plants bear a profusion of white or pink flowers. The stems separate into many branches, giving it a light appearance, perfect for accenting. They are most often included in those dozen roses you give or receive, and are a "must have" for bridal bouquets.

Common name: Baby s Breath, Gyp, Soap Root. Gypsophila

Color: White, violet. Small massed flowers. Five petals.

Bloom time: Early spring and summer

Height: 12 - 24 inches

Difficulty level: Easy

Planting & Care

Sunlight: Full sun

Soil: Well drained, pH 6.6 - 7.8. Average soil. Chalky soils.

Water: It does not like free standing water in the winter (this will lead to stems rotting).

Fertilizer: Add a general purpose fertilizer before planting if the soil is poor.

Care:

- No plant is easier or quicker to grow for masses of delightful blooms than this annual Baby s Breath plant.
- In just 6 - 8 weeks from sowing Baby s Breath seeds, you ll begin enjoying the tiny, pure-white blooms, which are set at the tips of rather stiff, very well-branched stems.
- Invaluable for bouquets and arrangements both fresh and dried, they are also a fine source of airy, misty color in the garden--particularly effective with large, brightly-colored blooms or with vertical ornamental grasses.
- If you want a steady supply of Baby s Breath flowers from spring to fall, just sow the Gypsophila seeds directly in the garden every 2 - 3 weeks as soon as the soil can be worked in spring.

Care:

- Insect and disease problems are not too common.
- If insect or disease problems occur, treat early with organic or chemical insect repellents and fungicide.
