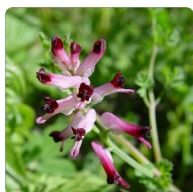


## Indian Fumitory Â - Plant

Description The leaves are mostly alternate. The gray-green leaves are divided into triangular toothed leaflets. At the top of the branches stand many small flowers, as it were in a long spike one above another, made like little birds, of a reddish purple colour, with whitish bellies, after which come small round husks, containing small black seeds.

The root is small, yellow and not very long, and full of juice when it is young.

**Color:** Pale-pinkish to whitish flowers.
