Description

Description for Iris (Random Color)

Irises are perennial plants, growing from creeping rhizomes or, in drier climates, from bulbs. They may be bearded or beardless. They have long, erect flowering stems which may be simple or branched, solid or hollow, and flattened or circular.

The bulbous species have cylindrical, basal leaves. The inflorescences are in the shape of a fan and contain one or more symmetrical six-lobed flowers.

Common name(s): Iris

Flower colours: Any color

Bloom time: Late winter, early spring

Max reachable height: Up to 4 feet

Difficulty to grow:: Easy to grow

Planting and care

They are best planted in September to December in warm sunny positions or in the autumn. Sowing season of Iris in the autumn and early winter season. Before sowing, you can keep the bulb in the refrigerator in a ventilated mesh bag for 12 to 14 weeks. The highest chilling temperature is around 4 C.

Dig a hole about three times as deep as the height of the bulb. Set the bulb in the hole, then covers with soil and press firmly. Planting space of bulbs 4 to 6 inches apart. Water thoroughly after planting.

Use the potting mix for bulb plantation as
Garden soil + Compost + Perlite + Sand (2:2:1:1)
Soil + Cocopeat + vermicompost (2:1:2)

Sunlight: Full sun

Soil: sandy loam soil

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 16 to 30 degrees C

Fertilizer: Fertilize in early spring with an all-purpose fertilizer scratched in around the plants, avoiding direct contact.

Caring for Iris

- Water a plant when the soil feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering for the winter & rainy season.
- Try to water the plants in the morning around 8-10am.
- You should remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and throw in the garbage collector.
- You should fertilize a plant mostly in the spring season, flower bud stage.
- Mulch the potting mix with organic material.
