Description

Description for Juhi, Jasminum Auriculatum

Jasmine Molle, which is a beautiful flowering plant and it, is known as "Jui" in Bengali of Jasmine Molle is "Jasminum Molle" and "Jasminum auriculatum" and this needs water regularly but over watering can be damage this plant growth. Leaves are opposite, ashy-velvety, sometimes hairless, simple or trifoliolate. Lateral leaflets are much smaller, rarely exceeding 4 mm in diameter, the central one up to 3.5 cm long and 1.5 cm broad, ovate, shortly pointed. Nerves Flowers are fragrant, in many-flowered cymes. Flower-stalks are up to 5 mm long. Calyx 3 mm long, pubescent, teeth minute. Flowers are white, tube 1.5 cm long, lobes elliptic, up to 8 mm long. Berry is 5 mm in diameter, globose, black. The flower is held sacred to all forms of Goddess Devi and is used as sacred offerings during Hindu religious ceremonies.

Planting and care

Jasminum Auriculatum is propagated from semi hardwood stem cuttings. Semi hardwood cuttings are pieces of plant stem which has matured partially after the current year growth.

Take 4-5 inches of stem cuttings with plastic bag and keep soil moist and shade for a week before planting. It can be grown from seeds too. Seeds can be collected from existing plant itself once pods dry on plant.

Caring for Juhi

- Jasmine plants can be affected by pests like aphids, caterpillar, spider mites, etc. and fungus disease.
- To avoid these problems,always water your Spanish jasmine properly without wetting the leaves and Ensure that the vine receives sunlight for 4-5 hours daily.

Typical uses of Juhi

Special features: Jasminum Auriculatum are very fragrant, the blooms send their fragrances in early mornings and evenings, not only in the garden but far away to neighbors area. This is one of the most cultivated types of jasmine

Ornamental use: Garden Uses : South of USDA Zone 9, this plant is usually grown in containers that are overwintered indoors.
