Description

Description for Kaempferia Rotunda

It is native to Southeast Asia and a member of the ginger family. The blossoms arise from the rhizome one or two at a time, each lasts only two or three days, but the plant blooms for four to five weeks. The back of the leaf is purple, the front is green and patterned with silvery marks.

Planting and care

Plant in autumn. Plant 3 inches deep and provide 3 to 4 inches of spacing. The pointy part should face up. Add some coarse sand or fine gravel to the soil to help improve the drainage.

Partial shade to full sun	Well-drained sandy loam	Moderate	13 to 23	Use any organic balanced fertilizer.

Caring for Kaempferia Rotunda

- During severe winter it is best brought inside into a warm area.
- In winter, cease watering and keep dry.

Special features: Flower. Tightly rolled, the leaves resemble purple spikes.
