Description for Kalanchoe Millotii

Kalanchoe millotii is a succulent plant that is native to the arid parts of Madagascar. It forms a shrub up to a foot high. The leaf is a hazy green and scalloped. Branched, hairy shrub; leaves covered with hairs; pink or yellow flowers. The young Kalanchoe millotii resemble a Cotyledon ladismithiensis.

Planting and care

Kalanches need lots of light, preferably a south-facing window in winter and bright indirect light (or east/west window) in summer. If your Kalanchoe plant is looking leggy and thin, it probably is not getting enough light.

Fertilizer
Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Kalanchoe Millotii

After flowering, shift the plant to a slightly larger pot. Kalanchoes are succulents that grow best in a well-drained and well-aerated potting soil, such as 60% peat moss and 40% perlite. Cut back tall growth and old flower stems. Keep well watered in a sunny, warm window.
