Description Leucaena leucocephala is a small, fast-growing mimosoid tree native to southern Mexico and northern Central America (Belize and Guatemala),[1][3] but is now naturalized throughout the tropics.

Common name: white leadtree

Color: White

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

The deep planting encourages the developing stem to send out roots to help stabilize the plant and perhaps eliminate the need for staking. Also, deep planting keeps lily bulbs cool when temperatures soar.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 22 and 30°C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Growing plants can be inexpensive, particularly when growing them from seed.
- Seeds of plants flowers should usually be sown directly into the sunny flower bed, as developing roots do not like to be disturbed.

Care:

- Place plants in full sun in average, well-drained soil.
- Drainage is important; don't place where roots will sit in water.
- Leaves develop best flavor in full sun.

Special Feature:

The legume is promoted in several countries of Southeast Asia (at least Burma, Cambodia, Laos[10] and Thailand), most importantly as a source of quality animal feed, but also for residual use for firewood or charcoal production.

Use

Note:

Caterpillars, mealybugs, and spider mites also cause problems. Avoid spraying and tolerate some leaf damage unless the situation is uncontrolled.
