### Description for Lilium Hybrid ( Orange )

Lilium is a genus of herbaceous flowering plants growing from bulbs, all with large prominent the garden. They vary according to the species and interspecific hybrids that they derived from, and are classified in the following broad groups

Common name	Flower colours	Bloom time	Height	Difficulty
Lilium Royal Sunset	Orange with yellow	June to July	3.00 to 4.00 feet	easy to grow

### Planting and care

Grow Asiatic lilies in full sun so they are exposed to at least six hours of sunlight a day. For optimum health and flower production, the soil must be well-drained and rich with organic matter, such as compost. To accomplish this, amend the top 6 to 8 inches of soil with 3 to 4 inches of organic matter before planting bulbs.

Sunlight	Soil	Water	Temperature	Fertilizer
Full sun to part shade	Well-drained soil	Medium	50Å° to 80Å°F (10Å° to 27Å°C).	Apply any organic fertilizer

### Caring for Lilium Hybrid

- Fertilize Asiatic lilies each spring when they emerge from the ground to help them bloom.
- Sprinkle a balanced fertilizer, such as 10-10-10 or 5-10-10, around each plant, then water it in with 1 inch of water.
- You can also use bulb fertilizer.
- Read the chart on the package for the correct application rate, because fertilizers contain different concentrates of nutrients.

## Typical uses of Lilium Hybrid

**Special features:** An excellent, showy flower that provides color and contrast to the summer perennial border. Also may be grown in pots or containers, but plants and flowers will be somewhat smaller.

**Ornamental use:** The plant is used for ornamental purpose

**Medicinal use:** Veterinary Clinical
