Description for Monstera Obliqua

Plant height: 6 - 11 inches (15 - 28 cm)

Plant spread: 4 - 6 inches (10 - 16 cm)

Monstera features big (2-foot-wide) leaves that look like they have holes or cuts in them, giving rise to two of its other common names: Swiss cheese plant and split-leaf philodendron. While young, this houseplant has a dense, bushy shape, but as it grows, it wants to vine out. Monstera can be kept bushy with regular pruning, or let it climb up a vertical support (such as fishing line fastened into the ceiling), for a decidedly bold and tropical look.

Common name(s): Hurricane, Swiss cheese plant, Split-leaf Philodendron

Flower colours: Whitish-green spadix and white spathe

Bloom time: Rarely flowers indoors

Max reachable height: 9-20 inches

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Initial care for 1-2 weeks after receiving plant at your location:

Do not overwater suddenly, check the moisture in the soil first. If too dry then apply water gradually.

Keep the plant in indirect bright light. Gradually move it to more bright location.

Do not re-pot immediately after receiving it.

Key requirements to keep plant healthy:

Sunlight: Full Sun

Soil: Well-drained soil

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 20â€“30 degree C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Monstera Obliqua

Sunlight

- Keep the plant indoor or outdoor with bright light.
- **Shield** the Monstera plant from harsh direct sunlight as it can cause damage to the foliage.

- **Watering** should be well drained and fertile for growing Monstera plant.
- Water the plant when the topsoil (2-3 inch) in pot feels dry to touch.
- Do not ever overwater the plant.
- **Application of Fertilizer** summer and reduce watering in winter and rainy season.
- During the main growing season (April - August) feed the Monstera plant with organic fertilizer once a month.
- **Re-potting** topsoil without disturbing the roots of the plant so it can uptake the nutrients and moisture easily.
- When a plant outgrows in current pot, re-pot with fresh potting soil and some fertilizer.
- **Plant Protection** late evening and keep the plant in shady area for 2 to 3 days and then move the plant in its suitable climatic condition.
- Large leaves can collect dust. If you notice the leaves are dirty or dusty, wipe the leaves with a damp cloth and gently dry to keep them clean and healthy.
- Remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and discard them away from the plants.
- For any insect attack or disease, you can use Neem oil, Eucalyptus oil or Citrus oil spray for primary treatment.

Typical uses of Monstera Obliqua

Special features: Large leaved indoor plant for warm, bright and humid areas.

Ornamental use: It makes an excellent container or house plant.
