Description

Description for Murraya Exotica, Andhra kamini

Murraya Exotica is a tropical, evergreen plant native to southern China, Taiwan, the Indian sub-continent, south-eastern Asia. The shrub is usually propagated from seed.

The flowers are followed by small oval red fruits with one or two seeds. The evergreen leaflets are dark green and pinnately compound with three to nine leaflets arranged alternately along the spine. The dark green leaves make a dramatic backdrop for the highly fragrant cream-coloured flowers. The shrub blooms most of the year.

Planting and care

Murraya Exotica planting material is seeds. It is sowing in the pot or main field. After sowing watering should be done.

Caring for Murraya Exotica

- Plant care is not difficult but does require vigilance.
- The vines need to be trained early when they are young.
- You may use plant ties or just weave them through trellis sections.

- Fertilize the plant in spring just before new growth appears. Pinch off the tips of the vines in the second year to promote branching which will fill the trellis with bushy growth.

Special features: Evergreen shrub or small tree with glossy, aromatic foliage, white bell-shaped flowers with a heady scent of Orange Jasmine.
