This is a low maintenance plant and pruning is done after late winter. Plants attract birds, bees, and butterflies to your Garden. It is an edible variety which produces oval-shaped juicy fruits. Plants also used for making hedges, Screening, edible garden & in a container.

Best planting season is from June to August but if the good irrigation system is available plantation can be done anytime.

**Water:** Moderate

**Temperature:** 13 to 37 degrees C

**Fertilizer:** Use any organic fertilizer

## Caring for Nimboo

- For planting in a container select a large pot with a minimum size of 18&apos;&apos; or above.
- Use well-drained soil for plantation. We recommended to you pinch off all the flower buds in the first year and let the plant grow.
- Daily watering is required for this plant.
