Description Tolerant of pruning and shearing. Little Gem is noted for requiring little pruning. Avoid cultivating around plants because they have shallow roots. Roots appreciate a good mulch (1-2 ").

Common name: araticum-grande , araticum-manso , cachiman épineux

Color: green

Bloom time: April

Height: 1.50 to 2.00 feet

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Plants do not thrive in Zones 9 to 10 without a period of refrigeration; they need a cold, dormant period. Select a site with soil that drains well. How can you tell? After a good rain, find a spot that is the first to dry out. Water trapped beneath the scales may rot the bulb, so a well-drained site is essential.

Sunlight: Full sun to part shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temprature: 36.0-38.0 °C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Give them plenty of organic matter when planting and don't crowd them.
- Wear sturdy gloves to protect your hands from prickly thorns.
- Have a hose or bucket of water and all your planting tools nearby.
- Keep your bare-root rose in water until you are ready to place it in the ground.

Harvesting: 2 weeks

Care:

- plant care may require a bit of effort, but the results are well worth the work.
- Not all plants are fragrant, but the most common and hardy do produce a sweet, carrying fragrance.
- Common is a vine and has larger glossy green leaves than Royal.
- Both can survive in temperate climates if they are planted in a sheltered area.
