Description for Passiflora Vitifolia

Passiflora vitifolia is a vine with cylindric stems covered in red-brown hairs when young. The name is derived from the shape of leaves resembling that of grape leaves. The flowers are a beautiful deep red. Leaves are five-lobed and flowers are slightly smaller, but with the same stunningly beautiful flower and edible fruit

Planting and care

Caring for Passiflora Vitifolia

Prune out inner growth periodically to keep plant open and healthy.

Typical uses of Passiflora Vitifolia

Special features:

Ornamental use: Used as a ground cover, on trellises or other supports for the lovely flowers and abundance of butterflies and hummingbirds they attract. Wonderful over a trellis as a shade-providing option or as a slope stabilizer, tropical selections can be grown as houseplants in a very bright window.
