**Fertilizer:** Fertilize your plants monthly to ensure good growth. Double-flowered cultivars like a biweekly dose of fertilizer.

## Caring for Petunia Glorious Double Mix

Petunias grow best in full sun, although they ll tolerate dappled shade, especially in hot conditions. They need well-draining, slightly moist soil. In soggy soils, they become leggy. Regular deadheading also improves their appearance. An early and midsummer application of high-phosphorus fertilizer improves both blooms and vigor.
