Description for Plumbago White

Plant height: 3 - 5 inches

Plant spread: 4 - 6 inches

Scrambling shrub, able to grow up to 3 m tall and with a spread of 2 - 3 m wide. Leaves are obovate with crenulate margins, up to 25 mm long, thin and light green in color. The leaf axils are winged with ear-shaped appendages at the base of each leaf. Another salient feature is the abundant axillary growth of leaves, resulting in many leaves of varying sizes being found all over the plant, and a distinctively dense and bushy appearance even in small plants. Flowers are white in color, borne on rounded terminal clusters.

Common name(s): Cape plumbago, Cape leadwort, Forget-Me-Not

Flower colours: White

Bloom time: Spring, summer and early autumn

Max reachable height: Up to 3 m

Difficulty to grow:: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Plumbago plant is propagated from the cutting. Planting season of Plumbago is in the monsoon and spring season. It grows in full sun and well-drained soil.

Sunlight: Full sun to part shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 20 to 30 degrees C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Plumbago White

- Water a plant when the soil feels dry to touch. Water thoroughly in the summer and reduce watering for the winter & rainy season.
- Try to water the plants in the morning around 8-10am.
- You should remove dead, infected or damaged plant parts and throw in the garbage collector.
- You should prune and fertilize a plant mostly in the spring season.
- When a plant grows beyond its limit and pot size not providing enough space for the spread of roots, re-pot with fresh soil and some fertilizer.
- While re-potting, try not to disturb the roots. Avoid any drastic change in the provided environment otherwise, the plants may get stress/shock.
- For any insect attack or disease, you can use Neem oil, Eucalyptus oil or Citrus oil spray for primary treatment.
