## Description for Pomegranate, Annar, Anar (Grafted)

**Plant height:** 14 - 22 inches

**Plant spread:** 4 - 8 inches

The pomegranate, botanical name *Punica granatum*, is a fruit-bearing deciduous shrub or small tree in the family Lythraceae that grows between 5 and 8 m tall.

Whether you train it as a tree or leave it as a shrub, grow these in your home garden to add a stunning splash of color. Pomegranates thrive in areas of warm, arid conditions.

**Common name(s):** *Punica granatum* ,Pomegranate, Annar ,dalimb

**Flower colours:** orange-red

**Bloom time:** Januaryâ€"February, Juneâ€"July, Septemberâ€"October

**Max reachable height:** 2 ft to 10 ft

**Difficulty to grow:** easy to grow

## Planting and care

Heat should be second on your pomegranate seed care list. These seeds will germinate at normal room temperature in about 30 to 40 days. Bring the soil temperature up a few degrees and you can cut this time in half. Try surrounding your plant with foil and placing it in direct sun until the seedlings sprout.

**Sunlight:** Full sun

**Soil:** well-drained soil

**Water:** Dry to medium

**Temperature:** 25 to 35 degrees C

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer.

## Caring for Pomegranate

- Pomegranates need full sun. Keep an eye on the weather report and if temps threaten to drop below 40 degrees F. (4 C.), move the plant indoors to a sunny window.
- Water the tree deeply about once a week, possibly more often during peak summer months.
- Fertilize the tree with the half cup of 10-10-10.

## Harvesting

June–August, November-January, February–April

## Typical uses of Pomegranate

**Special features:** Cottage gardens, wild gardens, meadows, prairies and naturalized areas. Good fresh cut or dried flower.

**Culinary use:** Mature fruits are used as the edible fruit and making the juice.

**Ornamental use:** The plant is used for the ornamental purpose.

**Medicinal use:** Fruit contain Fiber, Protein, Vitamin C, Vitamin K, Folate, Potassium.
