Description for Prosopis Cineraria, Shami, Sami

Plant height: 5 - 9 inches

Plant spread: 2 - 4 inches

Prosopis cineraria is a species of flowering tree in the pea family, Fabaceae. Leaves are double compound. The leaflets are dark green and have a tiny point. The tree is evergreen or nearly so. It produces new flush leaves before summer. The flowers are small in size and yellow or creamy white in color, appear from March to May after the new flush of leaves. The pods are formed soon thereafter and grow rapidly in size attaining full size in about two months time.

Common name(s): Khejri Tree, Jand, Shemi, Shami

Flower colours: Yellow or creamy white

Bloom time: Year-round

Max reachable height: Up to 15 ft

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

This plant is propagated through seeds and root suckers. Seed germinates best if the hard seed coat is softened first to allow the ingress of water. Then sow the seeds in the porous potting mix. Monsoon season is best for sowing and planting this plant.

Sunlight: Full Sun

Soil: Well-drained soil

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 20 to 32 degrees C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for Prosopis Cineraria

- It is well adapted to the arid conditions and stands well to the adverse vagaries of climate and browsing by animals.
- Choose the sunniest spot in your garden.
- Water the plant at the only growing season.
- Also, prepare the soil with fertilizers and plant feed before planting the tree.

Typical uses of Prosopis Cineraria

Special features: Shami plant considers a sacred tree.

Medicinal use: Prosopis Cineraria plant produces gum, which is obtained during May and June. The bark of the tree is dry, acrid, bitter with a sharp taste; cooling anthelmintic; tonic, cures leprosy, dysentery, bronchitis, asthma, leukoderma, hemorrhoids, and muscle tremors. The smoke of the leaves is good for eye troubles.
