Description The China doll house plant is a great indoor plant for you if you are looking for an attractive foliage plant. They grow into fairly large house plants with shiny leaves that will remind you of an ash tree. The plant can easily grow up to 5 ft but if you don't have that much room you can keep them at a reasonable size by cutting them back.

Common name: China doll.

Color: yellow.

Height: Up to 4 ft.

Difficulty level: Easy.

Planting & Care

Sunlight: Bright, indirect sunlight.

Soil: Any good potting mix.

Water: Keep soil evenly moist year-round.

Temperature: Average room temperatures 60-75°F/16-24°C.

Fertilizer: Feed every 2 weeks spring through fall with 10-10-10 liquid fertilizer diluted by half.

Care:

- Pruning china doll will keep the plant compact and attractive.
- Cut off as much as you need to in spring and summer.
- Yellowing leaves usually mean it has been over-watered.

Use

Ornamental use:

- Use it as a small shade tree for lawns or to soften a building corner in a foundation bed.
