Annona reticulata is a small deciduous or semi-evergreen tree in the plant family Annonaceae. It is best known for its fruit, called custard apple, a common name it shares with fruits of several other species in the same genus: A. cherimola] and A. squamosa or sometimes it is called wild-sweetsop, bull s heart, bullock s-heart, or ox-heart.

### Caring for Annona Reticulata

Always wear safety goggles; branches can whip back when released. Start with pruning shears for smaller growth. Use loppers, which look like giant, long-handle shears, for growth that is more than half an inch thick
