Tradescantia spathacea, commonly called Moses-in-a-basket or oyster plant, is a clump-forming evergreen perennial that is native to southern Mexico, Belize and Guatemala.

Common name(s): Moses-in-a-basket, oyster plant, boat lily or Moses-in-a-cradle plant.

Flower colours: White with blue blush

Bloom time: Seasonal bloomer

Max reachable height: 0.50 to 1.00 feet

Difficulty to grow:: easy to grow

Planting and care

Rhoeos are normally grown due to the fact that they are very drought tolerant. As a matter of fact, this plant will develop some serious issues with root rot and foliage diseases if the plant is kept too wet or watered too often

Sunlight: Full Sun

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: medium

Temperature: 20 F. (-6 C.)

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Caring for *Rhoeo Spathacea Vittata*

First, is the *Rhoeo* located in an area that has excellent drainage? If not, move the plant to a drier location immediately. In the process of moving the plant, while the plant is out of the ground, check the roots for root rot damage.

Typical uses of *Rhoeo Spathacea Vittata*

Special features: As a houseplant, grow in hanging baskets or along shelves. Outdoors, it forms an excellent ground cover. Rock gardens. Borders.

Ornamental use: The plant is used for ornamental purpose

Medicinal use: fever, cough and bronchitis
