Description Hypericum perforatum, known as perforate St John s-wort, common Saint John s wort and St John s wort, is a flowering plant in the family Hypericaceae. The common name "St John s wort" may be used to refer to any species of the genus Hypericum.

Planting & Care

Growing St. John's wort herb in a location with too much sun can lead to leaf scorch, while too much shade reduces the number of flowers. The best location is one with bright morning sunlight and a little shade in the hottest part of the afternoon.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: hot 2°c

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- John's wort makes an attractive ground cover and soil stabilizer.
- Once established, the plants need no care, and this makes them ideal for out-of-the-way locations.
- You can also use it as an edging or to mark boundaries and pathways where you don't want to obstruct the view.
- Other uses include containers, rock gardens and foundation plantings.

Special Feature:

Ground cover, rock gardens, border fronts, naturalized plantings. Also good for stabilizing embankments or hillsides. Good for planting under trees where it competes well with shallow tree roots. Allan Armitage calls this "one of the finest ground covers available."
