**Planting & Care**

There are three main varieties of Mahogany; Honduran, Central American and West Indian. Honduran Mahogany is also known as "Genuine Mahogany", a name that was coined a generation ago to separate it from Mahogany trees of less quality such as those grown in the Philippines.

**Sunlight:** Full Sun

**Soil:** well-drained soil

**Water:** medium

**Temperature:** 20 - 30°C,

**Fertilizer:** Apply any organic fertilizer

**Care:**

- Buy from SEED seller to get Original and Imported seeds of Swietenia macrophylla, known as Honduran mahogany, genuine mahogany, big-leaf mahogany or broad-leaved mahogany, Brazilian mahogany, large-leaved mahogany, tropical American mahogany, is a species of plant in the Meliaceae family that yields genuine mahogany timber.

**Harvesting:** harvested at 5 and 13 months

**Care:**

- Also known as Cuban Mahogany, West Indian Mahogany can be found in scattered plantations in parts of Florida and the Caribbean.
- The third type of Mahogany is found growing in its natural habitat along the coast of Central America.
- A short tree, it is of little commercial value.
- Honduran Mahogany has a straight, fine with an even grain, and is relatively free of voids and pockets.

**Special Feature:**

oblong-lanceshaped, or broadly lanceshaped, 12-21 x 2-6 cm, below laxly velvet-hairy. Inflorescence is a panicle, 5-10 cm; axis velvet-hairy. Flowers are solitary; flower-stalk 5-10 mm. Flowers are white or deep purplish red; tepals nearly free, obovate-oblong, 4--6 x 2--3.5 mm, usually minutely finely toothed on distal margin.

**Medicinal use:**

- Therefore, the search for more effective and safer herbal anti-diabetic agents has become an area of active research.
- Swietenia macrophylla King (Meliaceae), commonly known as big leaf mahogany (vernacular) and skyfruit (local), is used to treat diabetes and high blood pressure in Malaysia
