Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

The deep planting encourages the developing stem to send out roots to help stabilize the plant and perhaps eliminate the need for staking. Also, deep planting keeps lily bulbs cool when temperatures soar.

Sunlight: Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: medium

Temperature: 13 to 24 (°C)

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Apply a high-potassium liquid fertilizer every 2 weeks from early spring until 6 weeks after flowering.
- Keep moist in winter.

Special Feature:

Food (Herb & Spice: In Thailand, Vietnam, Laos and India, the leaves are used fresh as a culinary herb which has a similar, but stronger flavor

than Coriander (*Coriandrum sativum*).The leaves are used to season meat and other foods in Caribbean, Latin American and Asian cuisines.
Use

Ornamental use:

- The plant is used for ornamental purpose

Note:

Pre-chill for 2 weeks. Do not cover seeds or cover very lightly as light is needed for germination. This is a tender perennial and may persist as a short-lived perennial but treated as annual. Plant seedlings in an open, sunny position in moderately rich and well-drained soil. For local production of cuts, harvest when more than half the flowers are open. Will last 5–8 days. Withstands light fall frosts. Warmer temperatures cause leggy transplants. Set out at spacing 9–12 in. Small seeds.
