Description Winter hardy to USDA Zones 10-11 where it is best grown in fertile, organically rich, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun. In St. Louis, grow plants in pots/containers that are overwintered indoors in bright sunny rooms as houseplants.

Planting & Care

It grows as a densely branched shrub or small tree. This evergreen shrub or small tree grows as high as 15-20 feet, but can be pruned mercilessly, after flowering, to keep it compact.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: medium

Temperature: 145.344°E

Fertilizer: apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- It grows as a densely branched shrub or small tree.
- This evergreen shrub or small tree grows as high as 15-20 feet, but can be pruned mercilessly, after flowering, to keep it compact.

Care:

- To keep the plants tidy and continuously blooming, it is recommended that the clusters of seed pods ("green beans") be cut off.

Special Feature:

This tree has one of the most impressive contrasts between flower and leaves, yellow/green in the landscape. This large shrub or small tree is used as a shrub border, a screen, or in boundary plantings. The distance of planting should be 4 feet c/c.

Note:

No serious insect or disease problems. Watch for spider mites and whiteflies on indoor plants.
