Description Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Somewhat wide range of soil tolerance, but prefers moist, neutral to alkaline, well-drained loams (especially of some limestone content).

Common name: American arborvitae

Color: green

Bloom time: Non-flowering

Height: 20.00 to 40.00 feet

Difficulty level: easy to grow

Planting & Care

Loosen the soil to a depth of 12 to 15 inches. The deep planting encourages the developing stem to send out roots to help stabilize the plant and perhaps eliminate the need for staking. Also, deep planting keeps plant bulbs cool when temperatures soar.

Sunlight: Full Sun to Partial Shade

Soil: well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 10° C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer

Care:

- Some nurseries dig Thujas out of the ground and send them bare rooted or "ball & burlap".
- This can leave up to 90% of the roots behind.
- The tree can lose up to a year of growth, while struggling to replace its root system.
- You also risk losing the tree, since it is less able to absorb vital nutrients and water.

Care:

- Before winter, add 4 to 6 inches of mulch, simply to delay the ground freeze and allow the roots to keep growing.
- Leave the mulch until spring once the last hard frost has passed.

Special Feature:

Foundations and landscapes. A very large number of compact to dwarf cultivars of this plant have become very popular. Use

Note:

No serious insect or disease problems. Leaf blight may cause some foliage to spot and drop. Watch for canker. Leaf miner may damage leaf tips.
