Thunbergia grandiflora is an evergreen vine in the family Acanthaceae. It is native to China, India, Nepal, Indochina and Burma and widely naturalized elsewhere.

Caring for Thunbergia Laurifolia

- Leaves are leathery and have a distinctive, elongated heart shape.

- The beautiful 3 inch wide pale blue flowers are cup-like with pale yellow to cream blue striped centers.
- The bloom all the year round.

Special features: Trellises, arbors, fences or other structures in areas where winter hardy. Hanging baskets and other containers when grown as an annual.
