Description

Description for Tulip Van Eijk (Pink)

This is single flowered and brightly colored perennial variety, with long lasting flowers on strong stems. Generally green colored foliage and whole plant spread up to 15 cm. After the tulips have bloomed, leaves fade and turn brown.

Common name(s): Tulip Van Eijk

Flower colours: Pink

Bloom time: Spring

Max reachable height: Up to 45 cm

Difficulty to grow:: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Tulips grow best in full sun in a light, well-drained soil enriched with organic matter. Set them upright at the bottom of the hole, tops up (pointed side up), and space properly. Press the bulbs into the soil and cover with the prepared soil. Plant 5 to 8 inches apart from center of bulb to center of another bulb and Plant 6 to 8 inches deep. Tulips show charm during their growth in a sunny location. The bulbs can be lifted, dried, cleaned and stored in a cool place until further planting time.

Sunlight: Full sun, Partial Shade, full shade

Soil: Well drained/light/sandy, rich soil

Water: Medium

Temperature: 14 to 27 degrees C

Fertilizer: Use any organic fertilizer. Apply once in a 15 days span in primary months then do it monthly.

Caring for Tulip Van Eijk

- Tulips should not be grown in the same soil for several years, so replace with new soil every other year.
- After planting water thoroughly to settle the soil and to encourage the rooting.
- Add 1 to 3 inches of mulch for winter protection after the ground freezes.

Typical uses of Tulip Van Eijk

Special features: It is usually flower again for several years after they were first planted, making them more reliable than other options.

Ornamental use: It is a great option for growing in containers and herbaceous borders, and works well when grown with other tulips. It makes an excellent cut flower.
