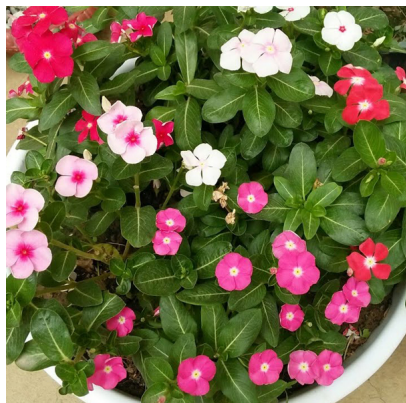

Description for Vinca (Any Color)

Plant height: 3 - 5 inches

Plant spread: 2 - 4 inches

The clear crisp flowers and glossy green leaves of annual vinca are so perfect you may be tempted to rub them to see if they are real. The plants are grown for its attractive glossy, green foliage, as well as its flowers.

Vinca plants are subshrubs or herbaceous, and have slender trailing stems 1 to 2 m (3 to 6 feet) long but not growing more than 20 to 70 cm (8 to 30 inches) above ground.

Common name(s): Vinca, Madagascar periwinkle, Myrtle, Nitya Pushpa, Sadabahar

Flower colours: Any Color

Bloom time: Annual

Max reachable height: Up to 2 feet

Difficulty to grow: Easy to grow

Planting and care

Vinca is commonly used for borders, edging, and ground cover or bedding plants. The plant grows in the ground or in the pot. Use the potting mix as the soil, vermicompost, and coco peat (1:1:1).

Sunlight: Full sun is best, although some afternoon shade is fine

Soil: Loamy Soil

Water: Moderately

Temperature: 26 to 30 degree C

Fertilizer: Apply any organic fertilizer.

Caring for Vinca

- Vinca or Periwinkle will grow in the range of light conditions, from full sun to shade.
- Watering should be done early in the morning if the soil feels dry to touch.
- Apply organic fertilizer in early monsoon and spring season.
- Mulch around plants in dry areas to help retain soil moisture.

Typical uses of Vinca

Special features: The low care nature of vinca plants helps them succeed in window boxes and other garden containers.

Ornamental use: This plant is used as the ornamental purpose.
